

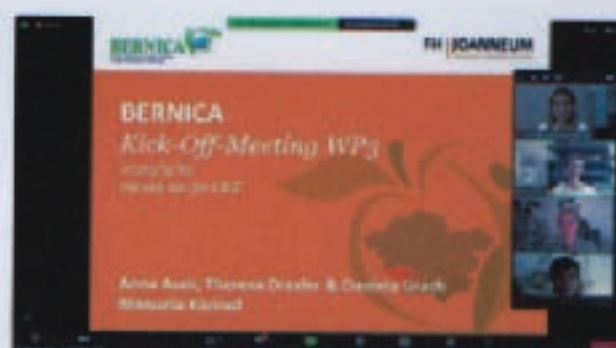


CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT: WORK PACKAGE 3 KICKS OFF

INTENSIVE TRAINING ON NUTRITION SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED

Osh State University's International Medical Faculty hosted a two-week (02.09.2025-12.09.2025) intensive training program on Nutrition, bringing together doctors, medical teachers, residents, young researchers and students.

The training was organized as part of the university's broader efforts to strengthen capacity in Nutrition and Dietetics education and practice within BERNICA Erasmus+ project. Over the course of 14 days, participants engaged in:

- Lectures and workshops on modern approaches to nutrition in preventive and clinical medicine
- Hands-on training in dietary assessment methods and evidence-based nutrition interventions

- Interactive sessions on the use of digital tools and blended learning platforms for teaching nutrition
- Case-based discussions on the management of obesity, diabetes, cardiovascular disease, and metabolic disorders

The sessions were delivered by leading faculty of Osh State University, alongside invited expert from partner university – Istanbul Medipol University, Associated Professor Indrani Kalkan. The training emphasized both theoretical foundations and practical skills, ensuring participants could apply their knowledge directly in clinical and academic settings.

At the closing ceremony, participants were awarded certificates of completion, recognizing their commitment to advancing knowledge in



nutrition and public health.

This initiative highlights Osh State University's ongoing role in promoting academic excellence and international collaboration in the field of Nutrition.
